

Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)

Senior Community Service Employment Program is a community service and work-based job training program for older Americans. The participant must be at least 55 years of age and have a family income less than 125% of the Department of Health and Human Services' poverty level. There are certain exclusions in the income calculation, such as Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI).

Enrollment priority is given to persons:

- who are 55 years of age or older
- have a disability
- have limited English proficiency
- have low literacy skills
- · reside in a rural area
- are veterans
- have failed to find employment
- are homeless or at risk for homelessness
- are formerly incarcerated or on supervision
